

Project Manager

This position requires practical and intuitive knowledge of commercial design and construction processes. The ability to work and think independently, while managing within a project team environment, is critical.

The Project Manager's role is to work within project management team to represent the Owner / Client throughout the project. The position will require continuous interaction with other Project Managers, client personnel, architects, engineers, contractors and material vendors.

Successful candidates for Project Manager will possess the following:

- At least one undergraduate or post-graduate degree in Architecture, Engineering, or Construction Management
- Minimum of 5 years experience working in the commercial construction industry (A/E, CM, or GC)
- Above average problem-solving skills
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Superior organizational skills
- Above average computer skills
- Working knowledge of the commercial building design process

The primary responsibility of a Project Manager is to act as the primary point of contact with the Client during the Project. The Project Manager is responsible for the oversight and management of the Project team.
